

## LESSON 4 PRAISE

Many times we hear people say, "Praise the Lord!" If you ask why they said that, they will probably answer, "God did this or that for me," or, "He answered my prayer about this or that." What they really mean to say is "Thank You Lord."

#### WE PRAISE GOD FOR WHO HE IS: WE THANK HIM FOR WHAT HE DOES.

# LESSON 6 CONFESSION

Another word for a way of saying "I'm sorry" is confession. The real meaning of the word "confession" is - to say the same thing God says about an action, word, or thought. Have you ever had to say "I'm sorry" to anyone at some time for anything? 2. Do you think God wants to know that you realize when you have done something wrong? \_\_\_\_\_Why or why not? \_\_\_\_\_ Do you think you can enjoy talking with God while you are deliberately doing 3. wrong? \_\_\_\_\_ What do you need to do in order to be able to enjoy being in God's presence again? Read 4. Psalm 68:18. \_\_\_\_\_ If someone has done a bad thing to you, he says, "I'm sorry." That is not enough, is it? He needs to ask your forgiveness. He may say, "Please forgive me, my friend." After you have said, "I'm sorry" to God, what is your next step?\_\_\_\_\_ 5. Our enemies cannot hurt us. We don't expect them to be kind and good to us. It is when a friend does something bad or wrong that we are hurt. It is only God's children who need to ask His forgiveness. (The only thing a non-believer can ask is for the gift of eternal life, then he becomes a child of God.) 6. In First John 1:9, what two things are we to ask for? \_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_ 7. Does God ever take back His promise?\_\_\_\_\_ So, if we confess – say we are sorry for our sin – can we be sure He has forgiven us?\_\_\_\_\_ 8.

This does not mean we will never sin again. It does give us a pattern for what to do when we do sin. BE CAREFUL – this does not give us license to sin again whenever we feel like it. We must learn to live as God wants us to live.

# LESSON 7 INTERCESSION

Often Christians will ask each other to pray for or about something. Praying for someone else's wants or needs is called "intercession." We are asking God for something on behalf of someone else.


